Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how Ethernal Payments OÜ ("Chbits", "we", "us" and "our") use cookies and similar technologies when you visit ourwebsite and use our Services located at Chbits.com, and/or interact with Chbits online advertisements or marketing emails (collectively the "Services"). It explains what these technologies are and why we use them, aswell as your rights to control our use of them.

In some cases, we may use cookies and similar technologies to collect personal information or information that becomes personal information if we combine it with other information. In such cases the Chbits Privacy Policyin addition to this Cookie Policy will apply.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small files, typically of letters and numbers, downloaded onto your computer or mobile device when you visit certain websites. When you return to these websites or visit other websites that use the same cookies, the websites recognize these cookies and your browsing device. A cookie cannot read data off your hard drive or read cookie files created by other websites.

Cookies set by the website operator are called "first party cookies". Cookies set by parties other than the website operator are called "third-party cookies". The parties that set third-party cookies can recognize your computer both when it visits the Chbits website and when it visits certain other websites and/or mobile apps.

We treat information collected by cookies and other technologies as non-personal information. You have the right to accept or reject cookies. You can choose to accept cookies by modifying your browser settings. In the event that you refuse to accept cookies, you may not be able to log in or use Chbits platform services or any functions that rely on cookies.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

We use the following types of cookies:

Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website and under our terms with you. These cookies are essential because they enable you to move around Chbits services and use certain features on our Services. For example, strictly necessary cookies allow you to access secure areas. Without these cookies, some of our services cannot be provided.

Analytical/performance cookies. These cookies collect information about how you use a website. For example, a performance/analytics cookie will collect information about which pages you go to most often, how much time you spend on that page, or if you get error messages from certain pages. This helps us for our legitimate interests of improving the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. These cookies do not gather information that identifies you. The information these cookies collect is anonymous and is only used to improve how Chbits Services work.

Functionality cookies. These cookies allow us to remember the choices you make and to tailor Chbits services so we can provide relevant content to you. This enables us, subject to your choices and preferences, to personalize our content, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language, currency or region). We use session cookies when you access our website or content. Session cookies expire and no longer have any effect when you log out of your account or close your browser.

Targeting cookies. These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information subject to your choices and preferences to make our Site and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

Advertisement cookies. Chbits uses third party service providers to display advertising on our Services and serve advertising on other third partysites that are more relevant to you or your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement, as well as help measurethe effectiveness of the advertising campaign. They can remember that you have visited a website, and this information can be shared with other organisations, including other advertisers. But they cannot determine who you are though, as the data collected is never linked to your profile. Such advertising on our Services will only be delivered where permitted by applicable law.

HOW TO MANAGE COOKIES

You have the right to decide whether to accept cookies. You can use the browser with which you are viewing this website to enable, disable or delete cookies. To do this, follow the instructions provided by your browser (usually located within the "Help", "Tools" or "Edit" settings). P lease note, however, that if you delete cookies or refuse to accept them, you might not be able to use some or all of the features we offer. You may not be able to log in, store your preferences, and some of our pages might not display properly. Therefore it is recommended that you do not disable cookies. may reduce the functionality of some Flash applications, including,

potentially, Flash applications used in connection with our Services or online

content.
